What is ProcurComp^{EU}?

ProcurComp^{EU} is a tool designed by the European Commission to support the professionalisation of public procurement. By defining 30 key competences, ProcurComp^{EU} provides a common reference for public procurement professionals in the European Union and beyond. It recognizes and supports public procurement as a strategic function that delivers public investment for sustainable growth.

Individuals can use ProcurComp^{EU} to identify competences they can develop further and design a personal development and career path.



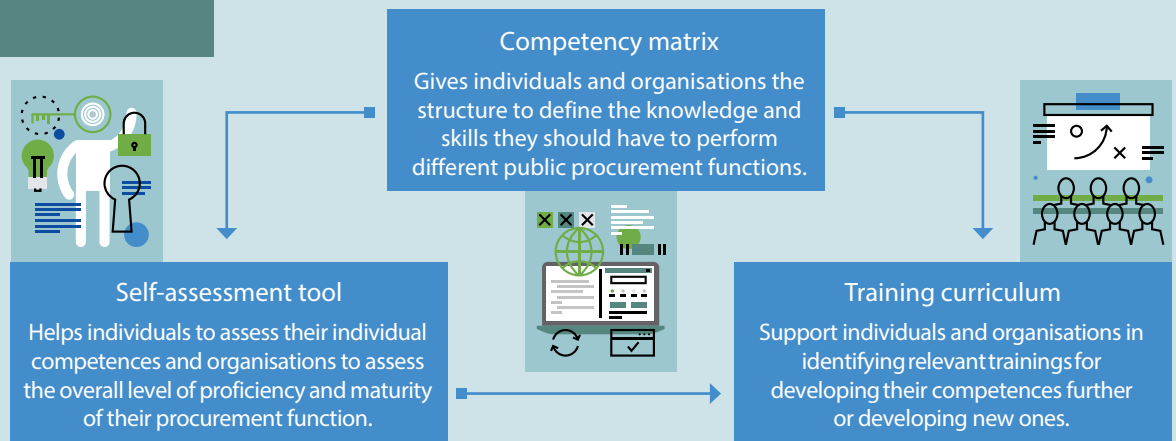
Organisations can use ProcurComp^{EU} to assess and enhance the capability of their procurement function to respond to the organisation's policy priorities.



Training providers can use ProcurComp^{EU} to develop comprehensive training and study programmes.

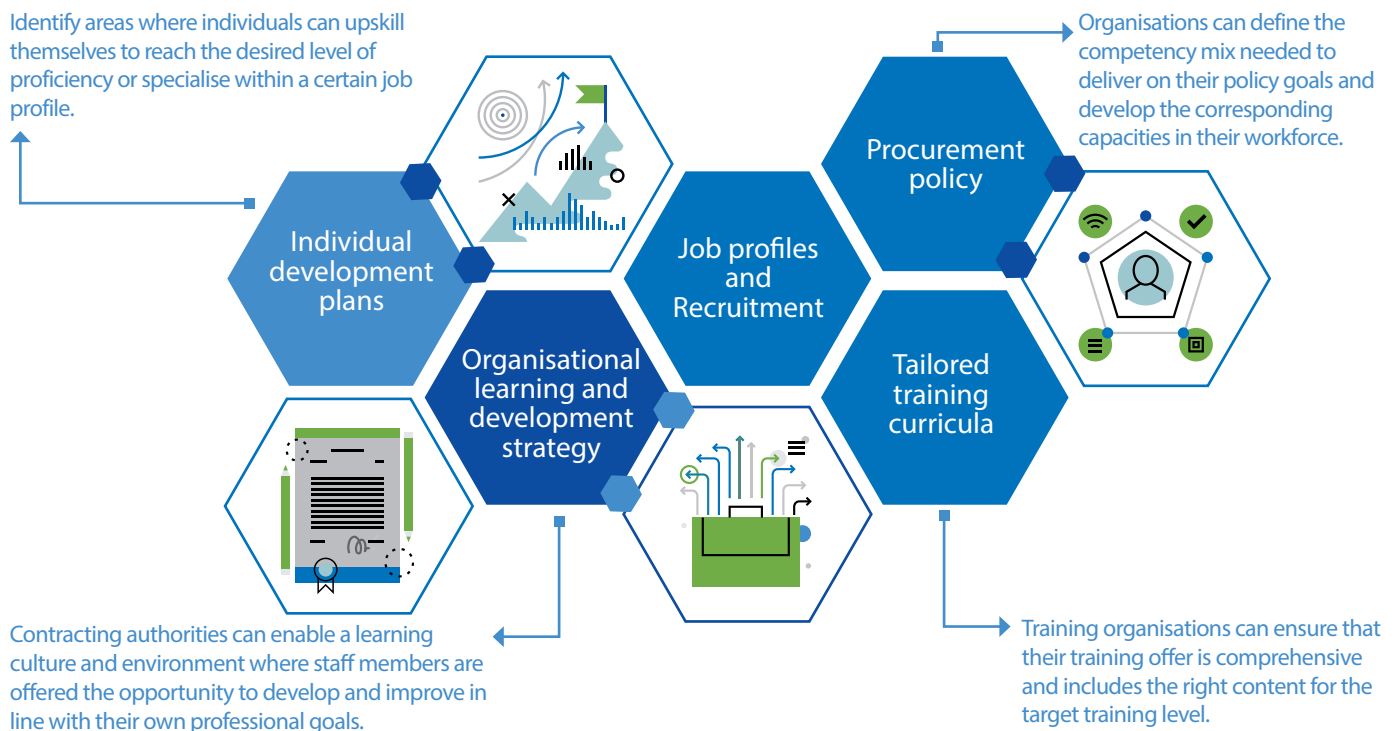
How to use the ProcurComp^{EU} tools?

ProcurComp^{EU} is a set of voluntary, free to use and fully customisable tools. ProcurComp^{EU} helps contracting authorities and individuals define what it takes to do their jobs well, identify gaps, and put in place targeted learning and development actions to address them.



What are the benefits of ProcurComp^{EU}?

ProcurComp^{EU} enables procurement professionals to play a pivotal role in facing current and future challenges in delivering high value investment and services for the citizens. It helps individual public procurement professionals to valorise their competences, facilitates training and professional development. It helps organisations to build the teams of professionals they need to reach their strategic investment goals and to encourage careers in procurement. It also helps training providers to build the appropriate training programmes.
